### **Four Strangers**



### This is what you need for the scenario:

- Six chairs
- A small table or stool
- Name tags that can be attached to shirt/sweater (stickers, tape you can write on, paper cards and safety pins, or something similar)
- At least one pen or pencil
- Scissors to cut out the tickets
- Four tickets (see page 7)
- One contract in Chinese (see page 11)
- Four character sheets (see page 15)
- Instructions for scene 2, 3, 4 and 5 for each character, 16 sheets in total (see page 23)

### Instructions for the game master:

### Ahead of time

- Print this document double-sided. Make sure that the right pages end up on the same sheet
  of paper so that all papers that need to be folded have the correct information on each side.
   For example, page 1 and 2 need to be printed on the same sheet of paper, and so on.
- Cut out the tickets.
- Fold the scene instructions and the character sheets so that the information isn't visible.
- Fold or staple the chinese contract so that page 2 and 3 (the content) isn't visible.
- Sort the sheets of paper so that you can keep track of them during the scenario.

### Preparing the room before the scenario starts

 Set out six chairs and one small table or stool like a train compartment. Place three chairs next to each other and the other three opposite them next to a wall, preferably under a window. Place the table/stool under the window.

### Introduction

Read this instrucion aloud to the players:

- In this scenario, you will play four strangers who end up in the same train compartment. You will board the train in Stockholm and travel to Norrköping, a town south of Stockholm. When you board the train, you have never seen each other before, but during the journey, you will get to know each other, and possibly affect each other.
- You will receive a character sheet with a short description of your character, where you are
  going and your goals. You can add more back story and characteristics as you wish, but do
  keep the characteristics in the description. The scenario will work better that way. Keep the
  character sheet with you in case you want to remind yourself of something during the
  scenario. Avoid looking at each other's character sheets.
- During the scenario, you will sometimes receive notes with sms messages and short instructions. The notes do not exist in-game, so when the other players are reading their notes, ignore them and pretend that this isn't happening. The same applies to character sheets. Pretend that they do not exist.
- This scenario consists mainly of conversation between your characters. Even if you choose
  to play your character as an extroverted person who likes talking about him- or herself, it is
  better to not tell everything at once. Leave something for the others to discover and ask
  about during the scenario.
- I will act as game master, and also act as conductor or train guard. It is best if you accept everything I say as true, even if it would be possible to question my statements. In this world, what I say will seem logical and reasonable for these characters.
- On this train, the seats not numbered. Your ticket is valid for this compartment and you can sit in seat that is not taken when you enter the train.
- The scenario has no breaks. When it is time to end one scene and start the next, I will make an announcement about the next train station. If you need a break, this will be a good time to do so. Stand up and say that you want to stretch your legs. We will pause and resume the scenario when you return.
- You do not have to sit still during the entire scenario, but everything should be played in the
  compartment or in the corridor just outside the compartment, so that everyone can hear
  what is said at all times.

### Prepare the characters

Hand out the character sheets and read the following out loud:

- You will now have the opportunity to read your character sheets. You can also invent a back story for your character.
- You will also invent a name that starts with the letter on your character sheet. You can choose to be which gender you like.
- Don't show your character sheets to each other and do not discuss the characters.

When everyone seems to be done, hand out the name tags. Ask everyone to write the name of the character and the preferred pronoun on the name tag and put it on. Write "conductor" or "train guard" on your name tag and put it on.

Read the following out loud:

- When the scenario starts, you have never met so you do not know each other's names.
   The name tags are to help you and me to remember the names, but they do not exist in-game.
- Has anyone planned on playing a character that looks different than you yourself do?
   Maybe the character has a big beard or certain clothes? In such case, tell us now so that we know what you look like.

Hand out the tickets.

Hand the chinese contract to player B. Ask him or her not to look at the document until the scenario starts.

Ask if anyone has any questions. If not, you can start the scenario.

### The Scenario

Follow the game master instructions below.

If any player tries to make a call or send a text with their phone, whisper in their ear that the phone isn't working and that they are receiving an error message. If anyone puts their phone in air plane mode, whisper to them that sms messages will still get through.

Remember that if anyone stands up and leaves the compartment to stretch their legs, this means that the person needs a break, for example to go to the bathroom. Ask the others to pause the scenario until the person comes back.

Follow these instructions:

### Scenw 1:

- 1. Read the following out loud:
  - It is time to start the scenario. Take a short moment to yourself to get into character, then enter the train and sit down in one of the chairs in the compartment. When you enter the train, the scenario begins. Once everyone are seated, the train will leave the station.
- 2. Once everyone are seated and comfortable, read the following out loud: Welcome to Tågbolaget and fast train 267 to Norrköping. We will stop at Södertälje, Vagnhärad, Nyköping and Kolmården. Unfortunately, the restaurant is closed on this trip and we do not sell coffee or snacks. We wish you a pleasant journey.
- 3. Wait a short moment and then enter as a conductor/train guard to check the tickets. Tell them that there are disruptions in the mobile network:

  We have been told that there are currently disruptions in the mobile network and mobile phones work only sporadically. We must ask you not to use your phones to try to call or text as it may overload the train's mobile phones that we need to be able to use in an emergency. If an SMS should come through, do not reply to it until you have left the train.

### Scene 2:

- 4. Once the players have had time to react to the new situation, announce the next station: Next station Södertälje, Södertälje next. Please disembark on the left side of the train.
- 5. Hand out instructions for scene 2 to each person.

#### Scene 3:

- 6. Once you feel that the previous scene has been played long enough, call out the next station:
  - Next station Vagnhärad, Vagnhärad next. Please disembark on the left side of the train.
- 7. Hand out instructions for scene 3 to each person.

### Scene 4:

- 8. Once you feel that the previous scene has been played long enough, call out the next station:
  - Next station Nyköping, Nyköping next. Please disembark on the left side of the train.
- 9. Hand out instructions for scene 4 to each person.

### Scene 5:

- 10. Once you feel that the previous scene has been played long enough, call out the next station:
  - Next station Kolmården, Kolmården next. Please disembark on the left side of the train.
- 11. Hand out instructions for scene 5 to each person.

### Scene 6:

- 12. Once you feel that the previous scene has been played long enough, call out the final station:
  - We are now arriving at our final destination Norrköping. The connecting train to Malmö will leave from track 1. The commuter train to Motala leaves from track 3a. *Please disembark on the left side of the train. Thank you for travelling with Tågbolaget and we hope to see you soon.*
- 13. Give the players a minute or two to react to the journey ending. Then enter the compartment and say:
  - I have a few messages to you that have been forwarded by the trainmaster, on account of the mobile phones not working. Let me see ...
    - o A, please go to the parking lot, where Anton is waiting with a car.
    - o B, please go to the railway café where Li is waiting for you.
    - o C is to meet Stefan on the platform outside.
    - For D, there is a message from Viveka to go to the Smack press conference at Louis de Geer Konsert och Kongress.

If you would please follow me, I will show you the way.

14. Leave the compartment and walk away. Let the players decide whether to follow you or not. Do not try to convince them.

### End

Once everyone have decided where to go and left the train, the scenario is over. Gather the players and tell them that the scenario is over.

If you sell and move to a new home (which would need to be much smaller and cheaper) in the same town, everyone will notice what loss you have made, but if you move to another city, no one will wonder why you are selling.

You **hate dishonest businessmen**. Everyone can make mistakes and mistakes are an inevitable part of everyday life in the business world. The important thing is how you act when you have discovered a mistake!

You want to **support others to invest in their careers and to try their wings.** You have chosen a managerial career because you want to help others to not let anxiety hinder their success, and you are happy to **coach people** even outside of work.

When you get on the train, you feel **hopeful and a little nervous**. You want to get hold of the chairman of the board as soon as possible to **book a time and place for the final interview**.

When you board the train, you are **stressed and focused on reading the documentation** about the product. You have not had time to open the booklet yet and you want to do it in peace and quiet when you get on the train.

You have always had **stage fright** and had hoped to avoid film, but late last night Sven called and told you to pack a bag and go to the health fair Skön & Frisk.

He quickly told you that the cameraman Stefan will meet you in Norrköping and that he will call later and tell you which stories he wants. Before he hung up, he told you that he wants positive news without difficult words that make for great headlin. You mean **clickbait**, you thought, but did not say.

You truly believe in facts and science as the path to success and happiness for mankind. You think that science journalism should have a much more prominent role in the media, but despite the fact that people need more help understanding our complicated world in order to be able to make good decisions in their everyday lives, most newsrooms cut back on science journalism.

You worry that your magazine's new investments in web and video are the first step towards sound bite journalism for social media. At the same time, you are happy that you have a job at all. At least you are still paid to be a science journalist, even if you do not always get to do the work properly.

The worst thing you know is frauds who make money on unscientific methods and products.

As a journalist, you often meet people who seem to be the right person in the wrong place - who have been "promoted to their level of incompetence". You wish that more people dared to take a step sideways careerwise and do what they are good at, instead of fighting to get on the next step in the career ladder.

When you get on the train, you are very nervous about standing in front of the camera tomorrow and you are stressed about not having received proper information from your editor about what features he wants. If you are going to be able to do this, you have to prepare well in advance!

You are the **chief product officer at Kolonialvaror Import AB**, which imports freeze dried fruit and berry powders that are used as natural seasonings or dietary supplements.

Kolonialvaror Import AB is a **subcontractor to the health food industry but also to the candy company Smack**, which uses the powders in its product range of fruit jelly candies.

You're **on your way to the candy company Smack** to smooth over questions that have arisen about the presence of **pesticide residues in the powders**.

You worry that the problems will become known. That would be bad for business, of course, but above all you are nervous that it could involve media attention.

You have had bad experiences with media during a scandal at your previous job, which you have not mentioned to Viveka, your boss. Ideally, you would like to pass this problem on to someone else, but you haven't been able to find a way to say so to Viveka without revealing the scandal you were involved in.

You detest journalists and their digging into the affairs of others.

You think there are too many regulations and that people worry about the wrong things. The important thing is to eat enough fruits and vegetables. If we are going to be able to supply nutritious food to everyone on Earth, we need efficient agricultural methods. That means not everything can be prohibited.

When you board the train, you are stressed about having to talk to Smack about the problems with pesticides in the fruit powders and are very worried that the issue will leak to the media.
